McANA Resolution on the Indianapolis Board of Waterworks

adopted January 9, 2002

We understand that removal of water from our reservoir system is a necessary process in which the Indianapolis Board of Waterworks will be engaged. We also understand that this can lead to lower levels of water in the entire water system, including our rivers and streams. Water levels in the rivers and streams have a direct bearing on the health of those ecosystems. Since the Indianapolis Board of Waterworks will necessarily remove water from the system, it should also have the responsibility and authority to make sure that this removal causes minimal harm to the health of the affected rivers and streams.

Therefore, McANA supports continuing dialog to pursue guarantees that the new Indianapolis Board of Waterworks will have the authority to initiate studies and make plans to maintain optimum water levels in our rivers and streams.
