Position on Variances to Permit Establishment of Billboards

adopted April 5, 2000

In reaction to the detrimental impacts on Marion County's neighborhoods caused by the proliferation of billboards which require variances from the duly adopted sign ordinance of Marion County, the Board of Directors of the Marion County Alliance of Neighborhood Associations, at its April 5, 2000 meeting adopted the following policy:

It is MCANA's policy to strongly support compliance with the Sign Regulations of Marion County, Indiana. This ordinance was crafted through an appropriate public process with input from all affected and interested parties and should not be varied without application of that same public process. The addition of signs in any area of our City which do not integrate with the protective overall concept of the Sign Regulations will contribute to a continual degradation of the Marion County environment. Therefore, MCANA will oppose all requests for variances to the Sign Ordinance as it is applied to billboards.
